

Monday - April 19 1971 113

Special Meeting of the Park Board with representatives of the American Legion, on Monday Evening April 19 in the Gray Laborers Hall.

Commissioners Present were: Russell Wiesemeyer, Oscar Gindler, Milton Langerwalter, George Schmah, and J. W. Dull.

American Legion Representatives present: Paul Frederking, Gordon McFarland,

Others present: Leeds Watson, and Wm. R. Thompson, Architect.

The Legion presented sketch plans for a pavilion which they hoped to build for the Park. The Legion had set aside ~~5200<sup>00</sup>~~<sup>5500<sup>00</sup></sup> for such a building. The material costs as estimated Watson would be about 5800<sup>00</sup> without concrete foundations, concrete floors, doors and toilet fixtures, sewer lines, gutters etc. The size of Building proposed was 104' x 49'-6" with 4'-3" overhang on roof, and of Pinta Treated Pole Construction.

It was moved by George Schmah, Seconded by Milton Langerwalter, and Carried that the Park Board approve of the Construction of a Pavilion as presented.

The meeting was then adjourned.
