9:15 AM - A special was held Feb 22, 1975 starting in the park to discuss the locate of the storage building and later at Russ's car wash to make final decision on the <sup>awarding of the</sup> contract.

A motion made by Milton Langenwatter to place the new storage building, after inspection of the park was made. It was decided to place the building along the west fence of Joe Shadwick's property with the north end of the building even with the north end of Shadwick's property. Having over head doors on the north end and west side of building, sliding door on the south end. The south end of the building to be used by the Lions Club, the north end for park use. Building will be placed in accordance with city zoning laws.

Second by Albert Arth. Motion carried.

A motion made by Albert Arth to purchase the storage building from Mark V buildings with base price of \$12298.00 plus gutters and downspout (alternate I) at \$518.00 and 2 overhead doors at \$675.00. One overhead door on west side of building and one on the north end of building. The sliding door on south end to be made as tall as possible, and 14ft wide. West overhead door to be placed in the north 33ft
