

The regular monthly meeting of the Iron Township Park District Board of Commissioners was convened at the pavillion meeting room on November 13, 1984 at 7:30 P.M. with president Russell Wisemeyer presiding. In addition to the president Commissioners answering present to the roll call were Aith Foucek, & Leonard.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved.

It was noted that ^{the terms of} Commissioners Aith & ~~Wisemeyer~~ ^{Langenwaller} will be expiring in April. Com Wisemeyer suggested Earl Jarmor to replace Com Langenwaller.

Motion made by Com Foucek, seconded by Com Leonard & carried to change the starting time for the monthly meetings to 7:00 P.M. for November thru March.

Mr. Somanisin stated that he will work thru the end of November & return to work in the Spring barring any emergencies in the interim.

A discussion followed on relocation of the main gate. Motion was made by Com Aith, seconded by Com Leonard to relocate the main gate across the road at the west end of the pavillion. Com Aith also suggested a Dead End sign be placed on the road to the gate & Com Leonard suggested that the gates be striped with luminous yellow paint. Com Wisemeyer agreed to inform Sr. Captain Center Director Al Lebigue that the Sr. Citizen van will have to park at the Center because the Kynone gate will be locked.

Mr. Somanisin informed the Board that he is winterizing the tractor. Also there is a ditch on the east side of the storage building that should be dug out.

The treasurer's report was read & the bills were read. Motion to accept treasurer's report & pay bills was made by Com Couch & seconded by Com Leonard.

Discussion on parking lot lighting. Com Thuesinger agreed to talk with Mayor Ciley & Mr. Schwab of All Power about additional ^{lights} poles along the street in front of the parking lot.

Com Leonard read a questionnaire on the park dues.

Com Leonard advised the Board that the grade school wants their playground equipment removed. It is available free of charge for repairing the blacktop after removal of the equipment. Motion was made by Couch seconded by Com Leonard to acquire the equipment for the park subject to approval of the Triad School Board.
