**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT**

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the Tri-Township Park District for 2000 will be held on December 13, 2000 at 6:30 p.m. at the Tri-Township Park Office, 409 Collinsville Road, Troy, Illinois

Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may do so at that time.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 1999 were \$300,936.55.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2000 are \$347,741.00. This represents a 8.0% increase over the previous year.

III. There were no property taxes extended for debt service or public building commission leases for 1999 and none will be levied for 2000.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 1999 were \$300,936.55. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2000 are \$347,741.00. This represents at 8.0% increase over the previous year.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A TAX LEVY FOR THE TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON AND STATE OF ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2000, AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2001  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT:

ARTICLE I: That this Ordinance be and the same is hereby termed the Annual Tax Levy Ordinance for the Tri-Township Park District in the County of Madison and state of Illinois.

ARTICLE II: That there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the real and personal property situated within the corporate limits of the Tri-Township Park District in the County of Madison and State of Illinois, the sum of Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-One Dollars (\$388,741.00), which said amount shall be raised by taxation upon all assessed property according to its value as the same is equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue and which said amount is to defray the expenses of the Tri-Township Park District as provided by the Annual Appropriation Ordinance beginning April 1, 2000, and ending March 31, 2001, as provided by Ordinance of said Tri-Township Park District as passed and approved on the 18 day of DECEMBER 2000, all of which was done by the Secretary of the Tri-Township Park District, the said Tax levy being in details as follows:
