ORDINANCE NO. 2001-1

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING PARTICIPATION IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE \* Board of Commissioners  
(Governing Body)  
OF Tri-Township Park District  
(Unit of Government), THAT

WHEREAS, Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code provides that a unit of government may elect to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund by the adoption of a resolution or ordinance of its governing body, participation to begin following receipt by the Board of Trustees of the Fund of official notice of the election by the unit of government and on a date specified by the IMRF Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the \* Board of Commissioners  
(Governing Body)  
of Tri-Township Park District, as follows:  
(Unit of Government)

1. That the Tri-Township Park District, Madison, Illinois,  
(Unit of Government) (County)  
does hereby elect to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.
2. That the standard for IMRF participation shall be a position normally requiring performance of duty for 1000 hours per year.

3. That the Secretary be directed to promptly file a certified copy
